Education Support Application for Gardening or Horticultural Projects 2024 Seed Starting Kits

The Muskingum County Master Gardener Volunteers are a group of volunteers who have received horticultural training through The Ohio State University and are interested in sharing their horticultural knowledge with the community. Local Master Gardener Volunteers work with the Muskingum County OSU Extension office to provide various types of community educational programing.

Teachers and youth leaders in Muskingum County may apply for a seed starting kit by completing the attached application. We expect that the kits will be used in conjunction with instruction about seed germination, pollination, and growing food as appropriate. Basic planting information appropriate to the seeds in each kit will be included. Recipients will be asked to report on the progress of their projects by submitting photos and brief updates. Details of this process will be provided when recipients pick up the kits.

A limited number of kits are available and applications will be reviewed in order of date submitted. Kits include labels, growing media, seeds, and three 24-cell self watering seed starting tray systems. We recommend supplemental grow lighting with these kits unless you have large south-facing windows. If you need assistance in this area, please indicate so on your application.

Teachers/youth leaders will be asked to submit a brief project report upon completion of their project no later than **June 7, 2024** and provide a poster board suitable for display at the Muskingum County Library. At the conclusion of the project, recipients will be invited to make suggestions for expansion of this type of project in the future.

If funded, the recipient will have a Master Gardener Volunteer available as a resource.
