## **Muskingum County Junior Fair Livestock Sale Scholarship**

The Muskingum County Junior Fair Livestock Sale Committee will offer a scholarship for 2019 graduating high school seniors or college freshman that graduated in 2018 who plan to further their education or are furthering their education at an accredited, post-secondary college or institution.

### Eligibility Criteria:

- Open to a 4-H or FFA member who is a 2018 or 2019 high school graduate.
- Must have exhibited a market lamb, steer or hog at the 2018 Muskingum County Junior Fair.
- Must be enrolled in an accredited, post-secondary institution in the fall of 2018 or planning to enroll in fall 2019.
- Must apply for scholarship by February 28, 2019.
